Class Targets

We will continue to earn our carrots for our class chart by displaying key BUB behaviours. The ones we are currently focussing on are lining up quickly and quietly, not speaking over others and using our indoor voices.





Phonics — In phonics this term, we shall be revisiting some of the phase 3 phonic sounds as required and shall also be learning some more of our new phase 5 sounds.

English — We shall be completing some non-fiction writing based upon Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder plot. We will be building up to write our own recounts of the plot, ensuring that we cover all of the key points in order whilst also using neat handwriting, full stops, capital letters, conjunctions, adjectives and when appropriate, exclamation marks. We shall also work with the text 'Blue Penguin' by Petr Horacek, which has a lovely wintery theme and shall help us to practise our descriptive writing and sentence construction.

Maths — This term, we will continue with our work on subtraction, learn to identify a variety of 2D and 3D shapes and tell the time for both o'clocks and half pasts. We shall also be delving into place value, as well as introducing ourselves to the world of fractions, in which we focus on halves and quarters of shapes, objects and quantities. Following this, we shall then begin some work on money. Science — This term in science we shall be beginning our work on electricity and creating our own electrical circuits using practical equipment such as batteries, wires, crocodile clips and bulbs. Following this we shall explore plants and trees in greater depth, looking into their structure and what they require to grow.

Music — Our music sessions this term will be focussing on learning our Christmas songs in preparation for our upcoming nativity play!

RE — Within RE this term, we shall continue to explore Christianity and what Christians believe. This term these sessions will be with Mrs Whittaker.

PE — During our PE sessions, we shall be creating our own wake and shake routine to music. We shall also be using and developing some of our football skills.

PHSE — This term we will have an anti-bullying week and will also be discussing those who are special to us and why and those we can talk to if we ever feel worried.

Computing — In computing we shall be working on our digital painting. We shall be using shape, line and colour and make careful choices to recreate some famous pieces of artwork.

History — Our history work this term shall link with our English and focus upon Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder Plot.

Art/DT — This term we shall be focussing upon painting. Within this work, we shall be exploring both primary and secondary colours, shades and light and dark. We shall also be focussing on a famous artist and creating some Christmas decorations towards the end of the term.
