CURRICULUM

English— This term, we will begin by focusing on the text 'Aliens Love Underpants' by Clare Freedman. We will be taking part in some fun drama activities and will be looking into characterisation, setting, description, letter and story writing.

Maths— In Maths sessions we shall be carrying out work on measures, exploring height and length as well as mass, volume and capacity. We shall also be counting in groups of 2, 5 and 10 and begin work on multiplication and division.

Science— In our science sessions we shall be exploring sources of food and investigating the difference between things which are alive, once lived and those which never lived. We shall also be planting seeds and nurturing plants to help them survive and observing the changes which take place as they grow.

Computing— In computing sessions, we will become storytellers! We shall be creating our own e-books with both text and moving pictures, incorporating some of the skills we have previously learnt this year.

RE— In RE we shall be exploring the question, 'how and why do we celebrate special and sacred times?' and will have a particular focus on the Easter story.

PE— In our PE sessions we will be learning a keysteps gymnastics routine as well as learning some ball skills including football. PE lessons will be on Thursdays and Fridays.

PSCHE— During our PSCHÉ sessions this term we will be thinking about money. We will consider what money is, why we need it and how people need to make choices regarding their money.

History— We will be learning about toys from the past and comparing those to toys we play with today.

DT— This term we will be creating our own 'moving book' using different techniques. This work will also link with our e-book work in computing sessions.

Art— We shall be looking at collages and how we can create exciting new pieces using mixed media.
