Term 6 Curriculum Overview

Maths – In our sessions we shall be exploring geometry, place value within 100, addition and subtraction, money and time, as well as recap and revising other areas of maths covered this year.

English – We shall be using the text 'The Barnabus Project' by the Fan brothers to base our writing upon. We shall write for a variety of purposes in order to practise our sentence structure, punctuation and use of descriptive language. We shall also be writing some non-fiction related to our work on the local area.

Science – This term we shall be focussing on forces and continuing our work on both light and sound. Our trip to Brogdale should also help us in our understanding of plants in an outdoor based, enjoyable way.

Art/DT - In Art and DT, we shall be using pastels and chalk to create a variety of pieces and we shall also be doing some cooking together.

Music – In our music sessions we shall be using the glockenspiels this term to perform together in an ensemble, learn some songs and compose our own simple tunes.

RE - In our RE sessions, we will be continuing to discuss sacred places what makes them this way. We shall compare some sacred places of different religions and look at what would be found in these places and why. These sessions will be led by Mrs Berry.

PSHCE – We shall be holding some discussions and debates around the key question, 'How can we look after each other and the world around us?'

Computing – We are collectors! We will be searching for images online and using our copy and paste skills to sort them in a document.

Geography – We shall be exploring our local area and the place we live. This shall cover types of buildings, simple map work, how to look after our environment and finding out about our location in the world

PE – In PE we shall be focussing on our rounders and dance skills.
